## Current grade 8 students entering grade 9

Students must select 8 courses ( 5 compulsory courses, 3 elective courses ( +2 Alternates). We recommend that students choose at least 1 course in each of the Arts, Physical Education, Technological Studies in either their grade 9 or grade 10 year.

This selection, chosen from the grade 9 Elective courses listed above, will only be used if one of your Elective courses cannot be scheduled.

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- French Immersion students must choose these three courses - FIF1DF, CGC1WF, and SNC1WF.
- Students who successfully complete Destreamed/Inclusive Academic courses in grade 9 can move directly into courses in that discipline in either the Applied or Academic stream in grade 10.
- Students who successfully complete Locally Developed courses in grade 9 can move directly into Locally Developed courses in grade 10 in that discipline If it is academically appropriate, students could take grade 9 Destreamed/Inclusive Academic courses in their second year of high school in order to move into the Academic or Applied pathway.

- If you wish to "reach ahead" and complete a full grade 9 course in summer school you will include this information in the "ADD COMMENT" box when you "REVIEW YOUR COURSES" in myBlueprint. In your comment, please indicate that you are going to do summer school and include the specific course that you plan to take.
- This course will not be in your schedule for next year. In myBlueprint you will NOT choose this course, but instead choose another course to fill this compulsory course slot in your Course Plan.

## ONLINE LEARNING GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

Beginning with the cohort of students who entered Grade 9 in the 2020-21 school year, all students must earn a minimum of two online learning credits as part of the requirement for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma. These types of courses are only available in grades 11 and 12 and there is a process for families to opt-out of this graduation requirement.
